

# PUBLIC NOTICE



## BRECKINRIDGE COUNTY KENNEL LICENSE

According to county Ordinance 2010-0913 "Any person who keeps or operates a commercial kennel, or any person who owns or cares for ten (10) or more dogs at their establishment or residence shall, in addition to a license for each dog, apply to the Breckinridge County Animal Control Officer for a kennel license. The living conditions of animals as well as the overall health of the animals in a kennel must be inspected and approved by the ACO prior to issuance of a kennel license. Proof of Rabies vaccination and current dog license for every animal four (4) months of age or older housed at the kennel must be provided to the ACO. Kennel licenses expire one year from date of issuance."

Commercial Kennel License and Non-Commercial Kennel license: \$50.00 yearly.

Kennel owners or operators must contact the Breckinridge County Animal Control Officer at 270-580-4299 to make an appointment for inspection prior to issuance of a kennel license.

All Commercial and Non-Commercial Kennels are subject to periodic inspections by the ACO during reasonable hours.
